

PROCEDURES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CLAIM TO CITIZENSHIP OF JAMAICA BY DESCENT

QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Persons born outside of Jamaica before the sixth day of August 1962 whose father or mother were or but for death before that date, would have been citizens of Jamaica.
- B. Every person born outside of Jamaica to a Jamaican parent becomes a Jamaican citizen on or after 6th August 1962.

PROCEDURES

1. Complete the form requesting the establishment of a claim to citizenship of Jamaica

Supporting documents required are:

- (i) The claimant Birth Certificate;
- (ii) The claimant father's or mother's Birth Certificate or Letter of Certification of Citizenship;
- (iii) The claimant father's or mother's Jamaican passport;
- (iv) Two (2) passport photographs of the claimant certified by a Consular Officer, Justice of the Peace or Notary Public.
- (v) Mother's Marriage Certificate where the married name is reflected on child's birth certificate.

Please Note:

i). For the purposes of the establishment of a claim to Jamaican citizenship by descent, a Jamaican parent is a father or mother who is a Jamaican by birth, descent or registration by virtue of marriage.

ii) Additional documents may be requested after the review of the application.
